E-Safety

- Very important that parents/carers made as aware as possible of e-safety
- Website could feature both an e-safety section and an e-dangers section
- Age restrictions (and the importance of adhering to them) to be reiterated to parents and carers
- Very important to impress upon pupils the importance of being strong in the face of peer pressure
- Advocate the use of tracking apps for parents and carers which can show parents where their children are and can allow parents and carers to see what their children are accessing on line
- Parent/carer talk by a qualified e-safety instructor – possible Year 3 parent contact

Response to behaviour issues

- Open door policy allows problems to be dealt with swiftly
- Possible use of the Facebook Page to promote the school's success in preventing bullying
- Advertise groups such as Parent Partnership and coffee mornings on Facebook page as not all parents/carers access the website
- Vary the time of the coffee morning and offer the occasional coffee 'morning' in the afternoon about 14:30

Gomer Learning Communities and Mathematics

- Mathematics GLC to be organised for Spring 2
- Offer a 14:30 and an 18:00 slot to cater for as many parents/carers as possible
- Organise one for upper school and one for lower school
- Remind parents of mathematics resources and advice available on website
- Parent/child workshops to be held for all year groups – possible start time 09:15

Learning Reviews and Reporting to Parents/Carers

- Continue with the Key Performance Indicator proforma
- Make it clearer which objectives have been experienced, achieved and yet to be covered
- If possible include a line graph showing how a pupils progress towards age related expectations
- Distribute to parents prior to pupil/parent/carer interviews
